How to vote in your neighborhoods
upcoming Neighborhood Association
election.



If you live in Southeast Portland, you live in one of our city's officially recognized neighborhoods—each supported by an association. A Neighborhood Association serves its residents by holding a welcoming and encouraging space for community action and input.

Visit your Neighborhood Association's website to find out where to participate.

WAYS TO VOTE

1. Slate/ Hand Raise
2. Electronic Ballot
3. In Person Ballot Drop Off

***Voting options vary by
neighborhood association**

SLATE/HAND RAISE

Before the election begins everyone on the call should verbally state where in the neighborhood they live and verbally certify that they meet the NA member eligibility criteria

Meeting is then recorded and sent to a SE Uplift liaison to be counted.



ELECTRONIC BALLOT

A ballot will be created online using Google Forms.

Ballots will be counted by an impartial person (in most elections this is a SE Uplift liaison)



IN PERSON BALLOT DROP OFF

People that cannot or do not want to vote online can walk over to the ballot drop off site, fill out a paper ballot and leave it in the ballot box (all while following social distancing rules).

Check in with your Neighborhood Association to confirm that they have a drop off option.
