<b>ENABLE</b> Enable and encourage residents to engage with one another independently of BDNA board	<b>ORGANIZE</b> Organize or carry out on behalf of residents - social	<b>ADVOCATE</b> Advocate on behalf of residents – land use, crime, parks, air quality, transportation, schools, services	<b>ADMIN</b> Carry out administrative tasks that keep BDNA functioning	<b>STRENGTHEN</b> Strengthen BDNA to prepare for hard times, disasters
